Dear Ms Worthington,

thank you for your message dated 02/07/2010, which was registered on the same day, requesting access to documents under Regulation (EC) No. 1049/2001 (OJ L145, 31/05/2001, page 43) regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents.

## **1. SCOPE OF YOUR REQUEST**

We understand that the aforementioned request concerns access to:

- “All documents developed and held by the European Commission that present information related to emissions into the environment from a combined data set composed of installation data in the CITL data base and information in the NACE code classifications for installations in the EU Emission Trading Scheme that were used in the assessment of sectors exposed to carbon leakage”;
- “Reports relating to the carbon dioxide emissions and allowances allocated to facilities or sectors as defined by the NACE codes and which are responsible for the implementation of the ETS Directive”.

## **2. DISCLOSURE OF THE REQUESTED DOCUMENTS**

The purpose of Regulation (EC) No. 1049/2001 is to ensure maximum transparency as regards the public at large. Since the information that you request might be of interest to


