The responsibility of enforcement of REACH in Liechtenstein is based solely on the Office of Environmental Protection. There is no general formal cooperation and information exchange for activities within the safety-, health- and environmental area with other EU enforcement authorities.

Until now Co-operation and information exchange came out with the German Federal Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (BAuA) in Dortmund and sporadically by joining the regular meetings of the EN-FORCE Working Group.

In addition, we would appreciate if the following issue would be considered on the future implementation of REACH:

Nanomaterials:

Even though nanomaterials are covered by REACH, there is still no sufficient legislation or guidance to secure safe nanomaterials. Nanomaterials with different properties than their bulk counterpart should be subject to the same information requirements as one substance in one dossier. In general, nanomaterials should be regarded as substances on their own to ensure their safe use.
